**Change of registration systems for competitions from January 2019
Information for clubs, for members and their parents/guardians**

Dear ladies and gentleman,
Dear competitors, dear parents,

We are getting closer to the date of changing into our new digital registration system on January 1st 2019. From this date onwards, the complete process of registration - from application to verification of conditions at competitions- will take place nationwide uniformly and exclusively via the new online TURN PORTAL.

All previous start passes to check the competition starting conditions will be invalid at the end of the year and replaced by the new DTB Identification Number (DTB-ID) and by an annual mark with the conditions for the DTB sports.

The DTB-ID must be requested personally by each club member, by each competitor, and in the case of children and minors by their parents and/or personal guardians. The DTB-ID has a fee of 20€ to be paid only once.

To register in the TURNPORTAL, each person should have a valid e-mail address. Once the registration has been successful, each person is entitled to apply for a DTB-ID. Personal data (name, last name and date of birth) and bank information (IBAN) for fee payment via direct debit needs to be provided. At registration, the competitors can already indicate their association membership. For members under 16 years old must upload a photo.

The process of personal data and photos is in accordance with the General Data Protection regulations. The policy can be found at <https://www.dtb.de/der-verband/verbandsdokumente/passwesen/>

In order to be prepared for the 2019 competitions, the DTB-ID will be already possible to request from 01.12.2018 at the TURNPORTAL.

Since a valid DTB-ID is a pre-requisite, we recommend all competitors to register in time and apply for it at the TURNPORTAL (www.turnportal.de).
